RCAC donated 36 pounds of cereal to People to People to help families have healthy breakfasts.

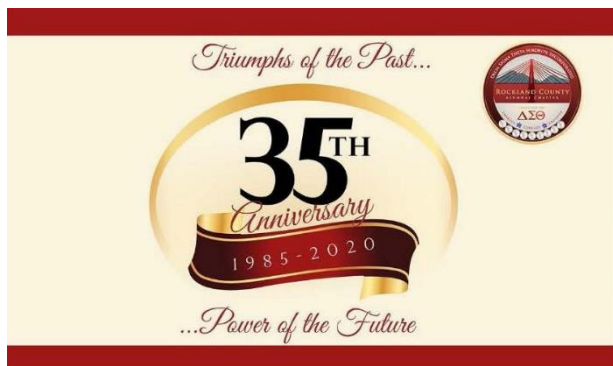
Partying with our Seniors!

Saving for a Rainy Day!



The old mantra of saving six months of take-home pay for an emergency is no longer. A new income analysis by JPMorgan Chase that reviewed six million American checking accounts suggests six weeks — not six months — should be the new savings goal for an emergency fund.

According to the study, to survive a simultaneous increase in expenses and dip in earnings, a middle-income family should have \$5,000 saved.

However, most of these families have just \$2,000 saved for emergencies and this figure drops more for low-income families, who are recommended to have a \$2,500 emergency fund, but have closer to only \$700 saved.
