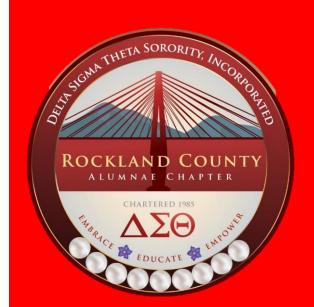

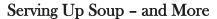

Congratulations Soror Couch-Jenkins!

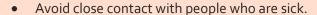

Practice COVID-19 Prevention

Here are some helpful preventative methods:



- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Stay home when you are sick except to get medical care. If you think you've been infected, contact your doctor before you go so that they can prepare.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with your elbow or arm.
- Clean and disinfect objects and surfaces. Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use a hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.
- Avoid crowds (virus can spread within six feet of separation).
- If possible and/or mandated, shelter in place, meaning stay in your homes except for "essential" activities (grocery stores, pharmacies, medical services, banks, gas stations, walking the dog or exercising) and work.
- Eat healthy fruits and fresh vegetables full of antioxidants.
- Take vitamin C.
- Stay hydrated by drinking plenty of water.
- Get plenty of sleep
