### Thinking of Getting an Extended Warranty – Think Again!

If you're buying a car, an electronic device, or a major appliance, you may be offered the chance to buy an "extended warranty" or service contract. Both service contracts and warranties provide repair or maintenance for a specific time. But there's an important difference: a warranty is included in the price of an item; a service contract costs extra. It's an add-on that might not be worth the price. Some service contracts duplicate the warranty coverage that the manufacturer provides; some cover only part of the product; and some make it nearly impossible to get repairs when you need them. Here are a few factors to consider before deciding to buy a service contract.

- Is the Product Likely to Need Repairs?
- Does the Service Contract Really Provide Extra Coverage?

- Who Is Responsible for the Contract?
